1. The Stability of The Demand for Money in Thailand

The objective is to test the stability of the demand for money in Thailand to make a policy implication for the choice of Thailand's target-based monetary policy. Money-in-the-utility function (MIUF) is applied to test for the stability. The result is that, after financial liberalization, the demand for money is not stable and, hence, money supply should not be used as a target for monetary policy.

2. The Impacts of Government Expenditure on Thailand's Economy

Small macroeconomic model is constructed to assess the impacts of government expenditure on Thailand's economy. The simulation results are in favor of the Classical model. Crowding out effect of interest rate, tax and prices remarkably limit the effectiveness of government expenditure.

3. The Feasibility of Gaming Internet Business near Bangkok's University Area.

The project feasibility analysis yields positive profitability in the short run with an estimate cost recovery of 8-12 months (rent not included). However, the downward trend in the number of players and forthcoming time-playing restriction for the underage population will make the project very risky in the future.
